MEMO DETAILS:

Staff will review the additional conditions we have developed to attach to our typical utility encroachment agreement for new underground utility installations within the Village right-of-way.

This was developed with the knowledge that multiple companies are wanting to enter the Pinehurst broadband market and will need to install fiber optic lines throughout Village neighborhoods and businesses districts in order to provide this service.

These added conditions will help staff manage these installations and are intended to hold providers accountable and provide reasonable guarantees of appropriate restoration to Village right-of-way and repair of private property damaged by providers that may be within the public right-of-way.
