MEMO DETAILS:

NC DOT has indicated the federal funding used to pay for the flower plantings at the Pinehurst Traffic Circle is no longer being provided. Further, it appears the State is not going to replace those funds in DOT's budget so this fall's plantings will be the last by DOT as it currently stands.

In order to have the spring and fall planting of flowers proceed, the Village would need to budget funds and manage the flower planting program going forward or until such time as DOT funding is replaced.

This discussion will center on whether Council would like for the Village to assume this role and discuss financial implications and current budget needs for the spring 2023 plantings.

Staff will need to put a contract in place this fall to grow the spring plants over the winter and install them next spring.

If Council desires to continue the spring 2023 flower planting we will bring a budget amendment estimated at \$20,000 to the next Council meeting.
