MEMO DETAILS:

The proposed Western Connector is a highway bypass to the west of Pinehurst to connect Highway 211 with either Highway 5 or US 1 near Aberdeen to alleviate traffic congestion on Highway 5 in Pinehurst.

Although the Western Connector has been discussed for many years, a right of way was never reserved, it was never funded, and the previously identified alignments are no longer viable due to development that has subsequently occurred. Today, Moore County leaders continue to deliberate on the Western Connector as they develop the Moore County Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) to cover all aspects of Moore County's transportation needs through 2040.

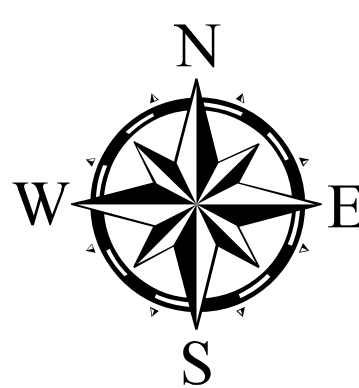

and Current Scenario

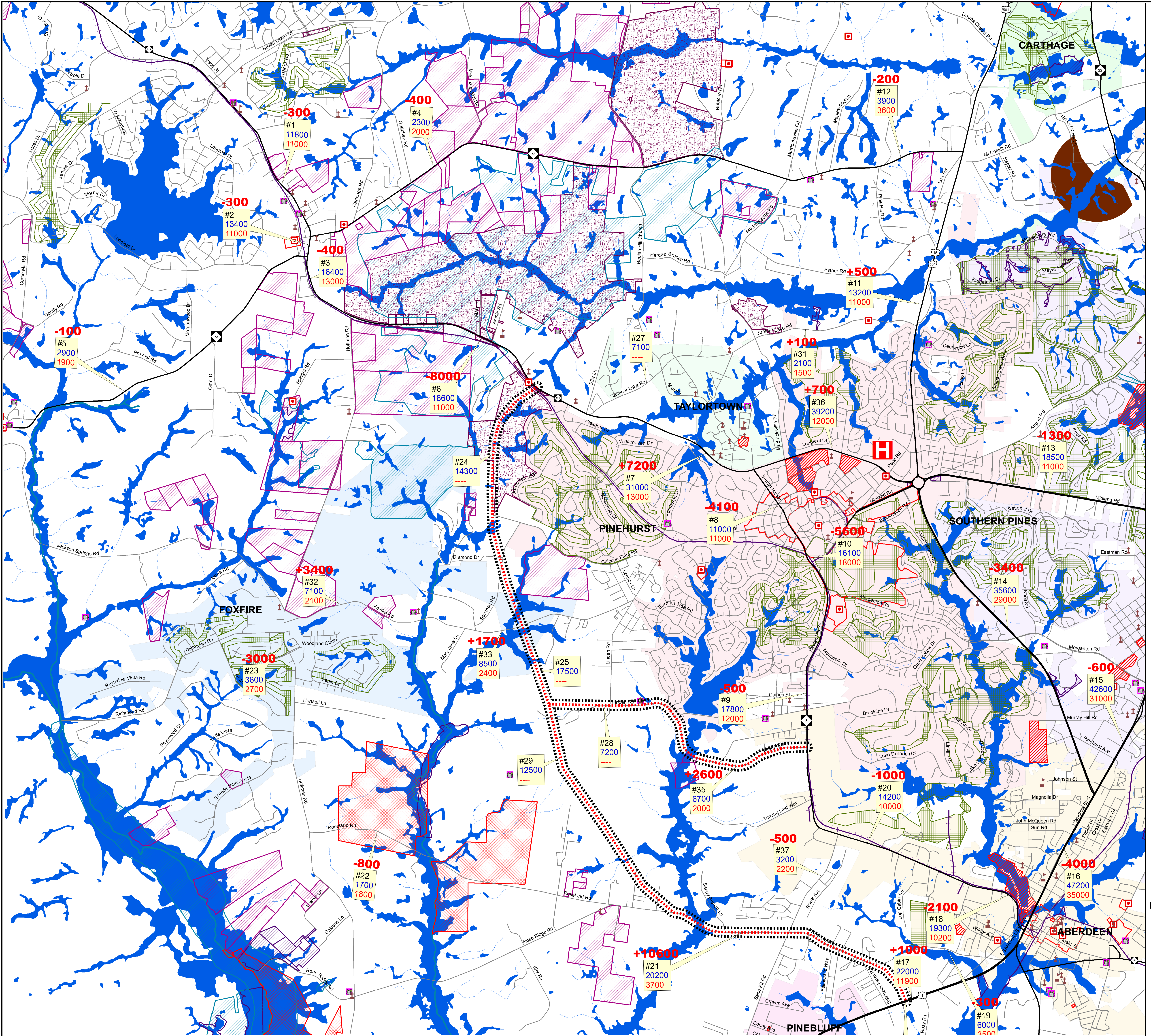

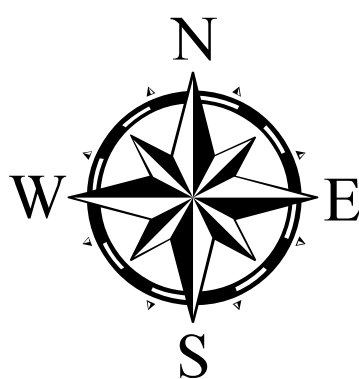
