- I. Call to Order.** Committee Chair, Lyle Covino, called the meeting to order at 4:03pm.
- II. Review Minutes**
  - a. Approve October 27, 2025, Special Meeting Minutes**

Lyle Covino, Chair, requested that section II a. be updated to reflect the correct date of July 14

Upon a motion by Casey Getman, Member, seconded by Jeremy Hooper, the Committee unanimously approved the updated October 27, 2025, meeting minutes.
- III. General Business**
  - a. Discussion of No. 6 Sidewalk Phase 1 and Phase 2.** Village Manager, Doug Willardson, provided an update. Phase 1 is 98% complete, staff is working to see if a footbridge can be built over the last section needed to complete phase 1. Discussion is in the works with the resident who lives in that area to see if they would allow use of their property to do so. Plans are also in the works at the southern entrance to put a crosswalk across 15/501 to connect to the Forest Drive path. The Village of Pinehurst will be advertising this Sunday to request bids from contractors for Phase 2. Bids will be due by February 3 so that council can approve during the February 10 meeting.
  - b. Update on Funding Sources for Future Projects.** Village Manager, Doug Willardson, provided an update. Currently the main source of funding comes from the Village of Pinehurst's annual budget. \$460,000 is earmarked for sidewalks. Other potential funding could come from state transportation improvements (has to be on the side of the state-owned road), Sandhills Metropolitan Organization- currently receiving funds from them for the Airport Road connection (waiting on DOT approval to start construction), and random grants that we could apply for. The main issue with most of the grants the committee has found is that they are very specific and have to be shovel ready.
  - c. Discussion of BPAC Member Recruitment.** There are currently 3 vacancies on the committee. Current members are going to ask around to see if any of their contacts would have an interest in serving on the BPAC committee.
